


God is always speaking

- 1 Peter 1:25a But the word of the Lord endures forever."
- Means is <u>continual</u>, alive and expectant!
- Once God speaks, He doesn't change His mind!

God reveals from our perspective

How the natural realm works




Fist the natural, then the spiritual

- Isaiah 55:10 "For as the rain and the snow come down from heaven,
- and do not return there without watering the earth...
- 11 So will My word be which goes forth from My mouth;

- It will not return to Me empty,
- without accomplishing what I desire,
- and without succeeding in the matter for which I sent it.

First the natural then the spiritual

God uses your imagination!

Your imagination has been sanctified.

- Every part of your life belongs to God including your imagination!
 1 Cor. 6:19
- Invite the Holy Spirit to take control of your redeemed imagination.

- Accept what God puts into your mind, is from Him. (Jeremiah 1:11)
- The Holy Spirit speaks 'ordinary'.
- Your dialect! Your vernacular.


The world is waiting for us to demonstrate God's ability!

The three "gateways"

 At least fifteen times in the Bible it mentions three ways (gateways) through which God communicates to us.



The apostle John says in...

- 1 John 1:1 What was from the beginning, what we have heard,
- what we have seen with our eyes,
 what we have looked at
- and touched with our hands,
 concerning the Word of Life—

The apostle Paul says...

- 1 Corinthians 2:9 but just as it is written, "Things which eye has not seen
- and ear has not heard, and
- which have not entered the heart of man,
- all that God has prepared for those that love Him."

Some say, "I don't get anything!"

- The Bible says...
- Hebrews 12:2

 fixing our eyes on
 Jesus,
- the author and perfecter of faith...

- Get a picture of Jesus in your mind.
- Focus on Him...
- Ask Him, 'What do you want to talk about Lord?'

<u>l saw you."</u>


How I started...
