# Our Tabernacle

God always makes every provision for us

Exodus 3:20.21.22

**20**“So I will stretch out My hand and strike Egypt with all My miracles which I shall do in the midst of it; and after that he will let you go.

**21**“I will grant this people favor in the sight of the Egyptians; and it shall be that when you go, you will not go empty-handed.

**22**“But every woman shall ask of her neighbor and the woman who lives in her house, articles of silver and articles of gold, and clothing; and you will put them on your sons and daughters. Thus you will plunder the Egyptians.”

# Our Tabernacle

Exodus 35:4-9

**4** Moses spoke to all the congregation of the sons of Israel, saying, “This is the thing which the LORD has commanded, saying,

**5** ‘Take from among you a contribution to the LORD; whoever is of a willing heart, let him bring it as the LORD’S contribution: gold, silver, and bronze,

**6** and blue, purple and scarlet *material*, fine linen, goats’ *hair*,

**7** and rams’ skins dyed red, and porpoise skins, and acacia wood,

**8** and oil for lighting, and spices for the anointing oil, and for the fragrant incense,

**9** and onyx stones and setting stones for the ephod and for the breastplate.

# Our Tabernacle

Exodus 36:3-7

**3**They received from Moses all the contributions which the sons of Israel had brought to perform the work in the construction of the sanctuary. And they still *continued* bringing to him freewill offerings every morning. **4**And all the skilful men who were performing all the work of the sanctuary came, each from the work which he was performing, **5**and they said to Moses, “The people are bringing much more than enough for the construction work which the LORD commanded *us* to perform.” **6**So Moses issued a command, and a proclamation was circulated throughout the camp, saying, “Let no man or woman any longer perform work for the contributions of the sanctuary.” Thus the people were restrained from bringing *any more*. **7**For the material they had was sufficient and more than enough for all the work, to perform and build it.

# Our Tabernacle

Does this still apply?

1 Corinthians 3:11-15

**11**For no man can lay a foundation other than the one which is laid, which is Jesus Christ.

**12**Now if any man builds on the foundation with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw,

**13**each man's work will become evident; for the day will show it because it is *to be* revealed with fire, and the fire itself will test the quality of each man's work.

**14**If any man's work which he has built on it remains, he will receive a reward.

**15**If any man's work is burned up, he will suffer loss; but he himself will be saved, yet so as through fire.

# Our Tabernacle

2 Peter 1:1 -9

**1Simon Peter, a servant and an apostle of Jesus Christ, to them that have obtained like precious faith with us through the righteousness of God and our Saviour Jesus Christ: 2Grace and peace be multiplied unto you through the knowledge of God, and of Jesus our Lord, 3According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that *pertain* unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue: 4Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust**

# Our Tabernacle

2 Peter 1:1 –9

**5**And beside this, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue; and to virtue knowledge; **6**And to knowledge temperance; and to temperance patience; and to patience godliness; **7**And to godliness brotherly kindness; and to brotherly kindness charity.

**8**For if these things be in you, and abound, they make *you that ye shall* neither *be* barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ.

**9**But he that lacketh these things is blind, and cannot see afar off, and hath forgotten that he was purged from his old sins.

# Our Tabernacle

## 1 Timothy 2:1-3

**1** I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, *and* giving of thanks, be made for all men;

**2** For kings, and *for* all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty.

**3** For this *is* good and acceptable in the sight of God our Saviour;

**4** Who will have all men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth.

# Our Tabernacle

## 1 Timothy 4:6-8

**6If you instruct the brethren in these things, you will be a good minister of Jesus Christ, nourished in the words of faith and of the good doctrine which you have carefully followed.**

**7But reject profane and old wives' fables, and exercise yourself toward godliness.**

**8For bodily exercise profits a little, but godliness is profitable for all things, having promise of the life that now is and of that which is to come.**
